Southern Explorer By Private Aircraft

DAY 1 | ARRIVE LAUNCESTON

Your journey begins in Launceston where you will be transferred from the airport to Peppers Seaport, which is located in the lively Seaport Precinct in the heart of Launceston. Tonight you will meet your fellow travellers at the Welcome Dinner hosted by the Journey Director.

Overnight: Peppers Seaport Launceston or similar

DAY 2 | FLINDERS ISLAND

Board our private aircraft this morning for the scenic flight to Flinders Island. Located in the waters of Bass Strait, off the north-eastern tip of Tasmania, Flinders is the largest island in the Furneaux Island Group. This group of more than 50 islands are all that remain of the land bridge which once joined Tasmania to the Australian mainland. We will tour the island and enjoy lunch before re-boarding the aircraft for the return flight to Launceston.

Overnight: Peppers Seaport Launceston or similar

DAY 3 | LAUNCESTON - FREYCINET NATIONAL PARK

This morning is spent visiting the historic town of Evandale and Woolmers Estate. A local historian will guide us through the homestead and provide some understanding of its nearly 200 year history. As part of the estate you will also have the opportunity to explore the magnificent Rose Garden. We continue our journey to Freycinet, stopping enroute at Campbell Town, known for its Convict Brick Trail. Check-in to our awardwinning accommodation overlooking the blue waters of Great



Oyster Bay. Freycinet Lodge is magnificently set offering incredible panoramic coastal views in all directions with The Hazards mountain range as your backdrop.

Overnight: Freycinet Lodge or similar

DAY 4 | FREYCINET NATIONAL PARK

Today we take a cruise on Wineglass Bay, renowned as having one of the top ten beaches in the world. Relax on board and enjoy the spectacular surrounds of this remote and stunning part of Tasmania. Explore the rugged coastline with towering pink granite cliffs plunging into the Tasman Sea and discover a coast dotted with sparkling white sand beaches before anchoring at Wineglass Bay. Absorb the peace of this remarkable bay and its magnificent surroundings while enjoying fresh Freycinet oysters, sparkling Spring Vale wine and creamy Ashgrove Farm cheeses. Overnight: Freycinet Lodge or similar

DAY 5 | FREYCINET NATIONAL PARK - HOBART

Our private aircraft awaits this morning to transport us to Hobart. En-route we fly over the spectacular eastern coastline, Tasman Peninsula and Maria Island. Enjoy lunch at acclaimed Frogmore Creek Winery before taking a historic tour of Hobart.

Overnight: Henry Jones Art Hotel or similar

DAY 6 | PORT ARTHUR

After breakfast, we spend the day exploring Port Arthur, the former convict settlement set on top of the Tasman Peninsula. This dark history contrasts with the serene beauty revealed today during touring and a harbour cruise. Full of powerful stories of hardship and loss, it is a striking visit in every way. Overnight: Henry Jones Art Hotel or similar

DAY 7 | BRUNY ISLAND

A spectacular discovery awaits on Bruny Island today where dramatic landscapes are matched by delicious island produce. Explore Bruny's wilderness, breathtaking coast, heritage and Australia's southernmost lighthouse. Stunning sights also await at Truganini Lookout, The Neck Wildlife Reserve, South Bruny National Park and Adventure Bay. We learn for ourselves how the island's local produce is as refreshing as its beaches, cliffs and wildlife as we sample throughout the day cheese, woodoven bread, seafood, honey and chocolate, all island specialties. Overnight: Henry Jones Art Hotel or similar



Day 8 | Hobart - Strahan

Transfer to our private aircraft this morning for a scenic flight over the pristine and awe-inspiring western coastline of Tasmania. In the afternoon we arrive in Strahan, known as the gateway to two of Tasmania's renowned wild rivers, the mighty Gordon and Franklin, which meander through the Franklin-Gordon Wild Rivers National Park. Lying in the heart of Tasmania's World Heritage wilderness area, it is a region of spectacular gorges and deep river valleys.

Overnight: Strahan Village or similar

Day 9 | Strahan - Cradle Mountain National Park

This morning we cruise the world heritage listed Gordon River including Hells Gate and aquaculture farms including a guided stopover at Sarah Island. Next, our flight to Devonport offers breathtaking aerial sightseeing over the Cradle Mountain region^. Encompassing some 161,000 hectares, Cradle Mountain - Lake St Clair National Park covers some of Tasmania's highest country and is renowned for its magnificent alpine scenery. At the base of Cradle Mountain, in deep depressions cut by glacial action, lies Crater Lake, Dove Lake and Lake Lilla. Transfer to Cradle Mountain Lodge located in alpine woodland.

Overnight: Cradle Mountain Lodge or similar

DAY 10 | CRADLE MOUNTAIN NATIONAL PARK

Today, explore this World Heritage area of rugged mountains, glacial lakes and wild alpine moorlands. An adventure to remember today as we discover this spectacular pristine wilderness including Dove Lake and Waldheim Chalet. The afternoon is at leisure, giving you an opportunity to enjoy this outstanding national park before heading out to enjoy a unique encounter with the endangered mysterious and secretive Tasmanian Devil, learning about these marsupials and their conservation.

Overnight: Cradle Mountain Lodge or similar

DAY 11 | CRADLE MOUNTAIN NATIONAL PARK -King Island - Launceston

Fly to King Island today to tour this unique island including a visit to the famous King Island Dairy. We fly on to Launceston and enjoy our farewell dinner this evening at the acclaimed Stillwater Restaurant.

Overnight: Peppers Seaport Launceston or similar

DAY 12 | DEPART LAUNCESTON

After a leisurely breakfast this morning transfer to the airport for your flight home. Say a fond farewell to new friends and take away memories of an unforgettable Southern Isles adventure.
