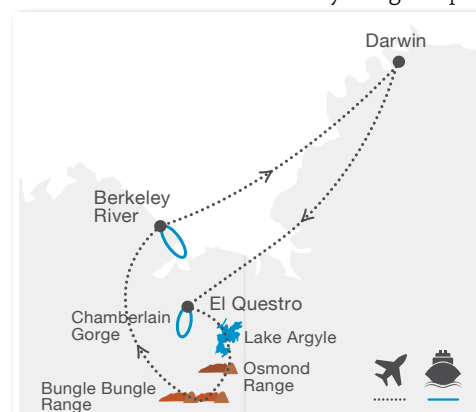

THE PRISTINE NORTH WEST BY PRIVATE AIRCRAFT

DAY 1 | ARRIVE DARWIN

Upon arrival in Darwin, a former frontier outpost, your private transfer will take you to the Novotel Darwin CBD. The balance of the day is at leisure to explore tropical Darwin or perhaps relax in your hotel, which is ideally located on the city's Esplanade overlooking Darwin Harbour. From ancient Aboriginal Dreamtime stories and the pioneering spirit of the early settlers, to survival stories of WWII, the bombing of Darwin and Cyclone Tracy, Darwin's history and heritage are vast, diverse and captivating in every way. This evening, join our Journey Director and fellow travellers at your Welcome Dinner at one of Darwin's finest restaurants this evening.

Overnight: Novotel Darwin CBD or similar

DAY 2 | DARWIN - EL QUESTRO

Following breakfast, we board our private aircraft for a flight along the East Kimberley coastline. Below us passes a land of breathtaking contrasts covering billions of years in history. Comprising in total over one million square kilometres, Australia's North West is one of the last true wilderness areas on Earth. Known for sweeping landscapes defined by rugged ranges, dramatic gorges, semi-arid savanna and a largely isolated and spectacular coastline, the Kimberley is a sight to behold.

Upon landing, join the traditional owners of El Questro Station, the Ngarinyin people, for the opportunity to immerse yourself in their culture and connection to Country. Witness ancient healing rituals, hear captivating generational tales, and delve into El Questro's rich history and ancestral heritage. Gain profound insights into Ngarinyin culture and language.

One of Australia's last frontiers, El Questro sits within what many consider to be the most spectacular rugged landscape on

earth. This evening, as vivid orange and pinks that paint not just the horizon but the whole sky appear, we discover why Western Australian sunsets are rated as some of the most beautiful in the world. Dinner this evening is at Emma Gorge.

Overnight: Emma Gorge Resort or similar

DAY 3 | EL QUESTRO

El Questro Wilderness Park extends for approximately 80 km north-south and 60 km east-west, totalling one million acres in size. Its landscape offers outstanding diversity - from rugged sandstone ranges and broad tidal flats, to rainforest pockets, gorges and permanent waterfalls. We begin with a visit to Zebedee Springs, a serene oasis of thermal pools and waterfalls set in the prehistoric forest of Livistona and Pandanus palms. Unwind in the inviting surrounds and for those interested, an opportunity to enjoy a soothing soak.

This afternoon, we embark on a cruise through the Chamberlain Gorge. During the cruise we will discover the diverse flora and fauna, resident rock wallabies, Johnston crocodiles and the always cheeky Archer fish, which are all familiar inhabitants of the gorge. Relax on the peaceful return journey at dusk when the colours of the Kimberley shine on the towering cliffs. Dinner this evening is at Emma Gorge.

Overnight: Emma Gorge Resort or similar

DAY 4 | EL QUESTRO - BERKELEY RIVER

After breakfast, your private aircraft is waiting to transport you to Berkeley River Lodge. Departing El Questro, the flight is to the northwest where the Cockburn range comes into view. This spectacular range is very unique with its vertical cliff running the whole way around the range. Enjoy breathtaking





flightseeing over the Argyle Diamond Mine, Purnululu National Park (Bungle Bungle Range), Lake Argyle and the Osmond, Carr Boyd & Ragged Ranges. Prior to landing, the Berkeley River and the Kimberley Coastline are revealed in all their majestic splendour.

Berkeley River Lodge is nestled on the gentle curve of Joseph Bonaparte Gulf on Australia's remote north Kimberley coast. A stone's throw away from some of the most spectacular untouched coastal wilderness on earth. From your dune top ocean view villa, you're just a sandy-footed stroll away from pristine wildlife rich bushland and secluded beaches, where the only frequent visitors are dolphins, dugongs and turtles.

Overnight: Berkeley River Lodge

DAY 5 | BERKELEY RIVER

Spend the day taking in this extraordinary environment, one of the last true wilderness areas on earth. In this, the ultimate Kimberley adventure, refined indulgence awaits in Australia's most remote luxury lodge experience, only accessible by air. On a river cruise to the impressive Casuarina Falls, glide past towering rugged cliffs to the remotest freshwater swimming holes, stunning waterfalls and majestic gorges, where the peace and tranquillity is broken only by birdsong. You will have the opportunity to visit rock pools, waterfalls, see ancient aboriginal art, experience Kimberley coastal fishing, all accompanied by experienced lodge guides in this most magnificent remote location, unlike anywhere else on earth!

Overnight: Berkeley River Lodge

DAY 6 | BERKELEY RIVER - DARWIN

Depart Berkeley River this morning for your flight to Darwin. Upon arrival you will be met and transferred to the Novotel Darwin CBD enjoying a city highlights tour on the way. Savour a farewell dinner while enjoying an exquisite tropical sunset during our sunset dinner cruise.

Overnight: Novotel Darwin CBD or similar

DAY 7 | DEPART DARWIN
