DAY 2 | BOWRAL

DAY 3 | BOWRAL - CANBERRA

This afternoon, enjoy a private Highlights Tour of the National Gallery of Australia which will include Jackson Pollack's **Blue Poles**, Claude Monet's **Waterlilies** and two of the gallery's newest acquisitions - Paul Gauguin's **The Farm at Le Pouldu** and Edvard Munch's **Man with horse**. Tonight's Farewell Dinner is at the acclaimed Water's Edge Restaurant.
