Day 2 | Christchurch - Picton - Marlborough

DAY 4 | BLENHEIM - NELSON

As the second oldest city in New Zealand, picturesque Nelson has many historical sites for those wishing to explore and a chance to learn about the history and settlement stories of old. Day 5 | Nelson - Wellington

Step back in time with a visit to Nelson's Classic Car Museum this morning. Leaving Nelson behind after lunch, fly commercially to Wellington and take a private tour of the acclaimed Te Papa Museum depicting the arts, culture and heritage of New Zealand. This evening is a celebration of exceptional regional wine and cuisine at renowned restaurant, Logan Brown as we enjoy our farewell dinner.

DAY 6 | DEPART WELLINGTON

Transfer this morning to Lambton Quay to ride the famed Cable Car to the look out taking in the striking panorama of Wellington City and its beautiful harbour below. Drive to the charming Old St Paul's Cathedral, a magnificent timber Gothic heritage landmark before returning to the hotel to check out via Wellington's distinctive Beehive Parliament House.
