DAY 2 | EXPLORE MORNINGTON PENINSULA

second light station which was built at Cape Schanck in 1859, located on the southernmost tip of the Mornington Peninsula. This afternoon, enjoy a guided wine tasting and lunch at Montalto, home to a famed sculpture walk, award-winning wines and a renowned hatted restaurant.

There is free time this afternoon to explore the picturesque village of Sorrento, where gorgeous heritage limestone buildings line the main street.

DAY 3 | MORNINGTON PENINSULA - AO TENNIS

After breakfast, transfer to Seawinds Gardens, which features a combination of indigenous and exotic formal gardens and a William Ricketts sculpture collection. Soar the heights of the Mornington Peninsula with scenic views across Port Phillip Bay towards Melbourne, around the coast and beyond.

Drive to Dromana Beach, known for its calm waters, colourful bathing boxes that line the beach and a pier that has amazing views to McCrae.

We arrive into Melbourne and check-in to Melbourne's 5 Star Heritage-Listed Windsor Hotel, a grand hotel where you will experience true Victorian elegance, a world of timeless beauty. Enjoy the

Windsor's famed Afternoon Tea before we take our seats at Rod Laver Arena. The excitement builds as we anticipate an evening of Women's Semi-Finals viewed from Premium seating in the Lower Bowl, which guarantees you a great view of the action.
