DAY 1 | ARRIVE ADELAIDE

Arrive into Adelaide and transfer to the Kimpton Mayfair, a heritage-listed five star boutique hotel located opposite Rundle Mall. Meet your Journey Director and fellow travellers at a Welcome Dinner tonight.

Overnight: Kimpton Mayfair or similar

DAY 2 | ADELAIDE - VICTOR HARBOR

Journey through rolling vineyards to McLaren Vale and the extraordinary d'Arenberg Cube. Enjoy a private introduction to its architecture and Alternate Realities Museum before exploring the Salvador Dalí exhibition, Greg Johns Sculpture Garden and Old Stables. Those who wish may also enjoy a wine or gin tasting.

Continue to award-winning Wirra Wirra Vineyards for the "What Harry Would Have" Feed-Me lunch at Harry's Deli, accompanied by matched wines. This afternoon, travel to Victor Harbor and settle into McCracken Resort before dinner.

Overnight: McCracken Resort or similar

DAY 3 | VICTOR HARBOR - KANGAROO ISLAND

Travel to Cape Jervis and cross Investigator Strait by ferry to Kangaroo Island, where our private 4WD adventure begins. Discover pristine Pennington Bay, where dolphins may surf the waves, before venturing onto a private farming property at Ella Matta for an alfresco bush lunch of grilled King George whiting.

Explore wildlife-rich Stokes Bay Valley, home to kangaroos, koalas, wallabies and endangered Glossy Black Cockatoos. Then follow a secret rocky passage to spectacular Stokes Bay Beach, emerging onto crystal-clear waters, white sands and a secluded natural rock pool.

Overnight: Ozone Hotel Kangaroo Island

DAY 4 | KANGAROO ISLAND

Journey into Kangaroo Island's wild western reaches, beginning at beautiful Vivonne Bay Jetty, a safe anchorage and supply point for the island's rock lobster fleet. Continue into Flinders Chase National Park to dramatic Admirals Arch, a spectacular coastal grotto sculpted by the relentless power of the Southern Ocean, where long-nosed fur seals gather on the rugged rocks and swim effortlessly through the crashing waves. Nearby is the stunning Cape du Couedic Lighthouse, built in 1909 in response to several catastrophic shipwrecks in the 19th century.

At historic Weirs Cove, discover how lighthouse supplies were once hauled up towering cliffs by cable system. Then marvel at Remarkable Rocks, immense sculpted granite forms balanced dramatically above the ocean. Enjoy a relaxed picnic lunch surrounded by the wilderness of Rocky River.

Overnight: Ozone Hotel Kangaroo Island

DAY 5 | KANGAROO ISLAND

Begin at peaceful Duck Lagoon, once a

centre for timber milling, farming and eucalyptus oil production and now a haven for koalas and birdlife. At Kangaroo Island Wool, take a private behind-the-scenes tour of the small-batch mill and experience Australia's only nine-metre Igloo Dome.

Continue to Seal Bay Conservation Park for a private guided encounter among wild Australian sea lions on their beautiful sandy beach, watching playful pups frolic in the surf and impressive old bulls resting ashore. Explore Cygnet Valley's inspiring habitat restoration project, transforming former farmland into thriving native bushland. Tonight, celebrate with a memorable seafood degustation Farewell Dinner at Samphire Restaurant, showcasing the exceptional fresh produce and flavours of Kangaroo Island.

Overnight: Ozone Hotel Kangaroo Island

DAY 6 | KANGAROO ISLAND - DEPART ADELAIDE

After breakfast at the hotel we fly to Adelaide Airport for your flight home, taking with you memories of a delightful South Australian Sojourn.
