DAY 4 | NORFOLK ISLAND

In 1856, the Pitcairn community resettled on Norfolk Island, bringing traditions, language and stories that remain integral to island life today. Following lunch, delve deeper into Norfolk's powerful past on a Convict Kingston Tour. Among the ruins and preserved Georgian buildings, learn of the First and Second British settlements and the fascinating lives shaped by this penal colony. Return to Governor's Lodge before dinner at Baileys Restaurant.

DAY 5 | NORFOLK ISLAND

Begin with a relaxed breakfast bushwalk through one of Norfolk Island's beautiful national park trails, as your guide reveals native grasses, ferns, shrubs, towering trees and abundant birdlife. Next, step inside the former home of world-

renowned author Colleen McCullough, preserved as she left it, and hear stories of her remarkable career and enduring love for the island. After lunch, cruise the crystal-clear lagoon of Emily and Slaughter Bays aboard a glass-bottom boat. Gaze beneath the water at colourful coral gardens flourishing within one of the world's southernmost coral reef systems. This evening, celebrate your island journey with an elegant farewell dinner at acclaimed Homestead Restaurant.

DAY 6 | NORFOLK ISLAND - SYDNEY

After breakfast, visit Fletcher's Mutiny Cyclorama, a vivid 360-degree panoramic painting that brings the story of the Bounty adventures and Norfolk Island's settlement to life. Following a light lunch at Governor's Lodge, transfer to the airport for your flight to Sydney, farewelling new friends and an enchanting island sanctuary.
