Following lunch, explore the fascinating historic Museums and UNESCO World Heritage-listed buildings at Kingston, considered to be one of the most important and intact convict sites in the world. Here we explore Norfolk Island's powerful and layered past of punishment, survival and settlement in the Pacific.

DAY 5 | NORFOLK ISLAND

This morning's breakfast bushwalk is a relaxed ramble through one of the Island's many National Park trails, where our guide will help us identify local grasses, ferns, shrubs and trees as well as bird species.

Next, visit world-renowned author,

Colleen McCullough's house, home to the modern day literary icon for 36 years and learn about her love for Norfolk Island and her literary triumphs.

This afternoon, enjoy a viewing of local home gardens. Enjoying a subtropical climate, Norfolk Island is volcanic, with 10 metres of topsoil making it home to many endemic species of trees and plants.

Tonight's farewell dinner will be at the acclaimed Homestead Restaurant.

DAY 6 | NORFOLK ISLAND - SYDNEY

This morning enjoy a visit to the Bounty Folk Museum, which showcases the four settlements on Norfolk Island. Following lunch, transfer to the airport for the flight to Sydney, where we say farewell to new friends and take away memories of an idyllic island Sojourn.
